- Situational Update: Last week had 12 fires for 1428 acres. Biggest fire was the Perkinsville Fire in Chino Valley. Fire was wind driven with hot, dry conditions. Picked up by initial attack forces with assist from Airtanker at 1408 acres.
- D-110 classes on going at ADC. Attendees from local government agencies. Utilizing Gila County Command trailer and Phoenix Fire generator. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> class that we have offered. If you have personnel interested in a future class, contact Pete Masiel at ADC.
- Dispatch center conducted 4 resource group test calls earlier in the week. A few glitches but overall successful. An updated version of the resource information sheet (appendix F from the Mob Plan) and a step by step process guide are attached to these notes. Test calls will continue next week for the groups not yet contacted.
- Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) continues to be open for 24/7 operations.
- Arizona is currently in Preparedness level 1 with Southwest Region in Preparedness Level 2. Arizona may increase to Preparedness Level 2 within the next week or two as activity increases.
- AZFD is continuing to work on the website. Working with the contractor at this point.
