## Current Fire Activity



June 25, 2016 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

National Preparedness Level: **2**  
Southwest Area: **3**      Arizona Forestry: **4**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 1,360 lightning strikes (72 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Expect mainly dry and hot conditions into the weekend, with a few showers and thunderstorms. Temperatures will be above normal early next week and decrease as moisture moves into the region.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 7 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources was dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


