Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 3,331 lightning strikes (150 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Monsoon activity will be on the increase over the next few days as a moist southerly flow develops over Arizona.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 13 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 10 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


