## Current Fire Activity



June 30, 2016 0800 hrs

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 2,758 lightning strikes (262 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Monsoonal moisture will bring continued chances for showers and thunderstorms through at least Friday. Due to increased cloud cover, high temperatures will fall below 100 degrees today and Friday.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 10 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 11 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.




