Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received no lightning strikes in the past 24 hours. Warm and dry conditions will remain in place across the region this entire week. Moisture returning to the south will bring isolated afternoon showers and thunderstorms to the southeast portion of the state today through Friday.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 5 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. One resource was dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


