## Current Fire Activity

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 840 lightning strikes (87 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. A Red Flag Warning is in effect today from 11am through 8pm in Mohave County for strong winds and low relative humidity. Monsoon moisture will return over the coming week with the potential for showers and thunderstorms over higher terrain throughout the state.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 4 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 4 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


