Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 22,544 lightning strikes (1,426 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Dry conditions spread eastward today into the state with reduced chances for showers and thunderstorms confined to higher elevations. Temperatures continue to increase through Friday.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 11 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. One resource was dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


