Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 15,149 lightning strikes (733 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Showers and thunderstorms are expected for much of Northern Arizona. In Central and Southeastern Arizona expect hotter and drier conditions with record high temperatures. An excessive heat warning is in effect for La Paz, Maricopa, and Yuma Counties and also portions of Pinal County.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 6 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 2 wildfires in the past 24 hours. No resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


