Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 4,079 lightning strikes (167 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. An increase in moisture over the region will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms mainly over higher terrain across the state for the next several days. An excessive heat warning is still in effect for portions of Coconino County.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 8 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 6 wildfires in the past 24 hours. Two resources were dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


