



# ARIZONA STATE FORESTRY DIVISION EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## Current Fire Activity



July 27, 2016 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)  
National Preparedness Level: **3**  
Southwest Area: **3**      Arizona Forestry: **3**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 6,321 lightning strikes (441 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. An excessive heat warning is in effect for Mohave County and portions of Coconino County from 8am this morning through 11pm on Thursday. A drier air mass moves into the state with a low grade monsoonal weather pattern with scattered thunderstorms across higher terrain over the next several days.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 8 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 7 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 5 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


