Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 2,689 lightning strikes (233 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. An excessive heat warning is still in effect for Mohave County through 8pm Friday and for portions of Coconino County through 11pm today. Expect a cooling trend with increased chances for showers and thunderstorms by the start of the weekend.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 5 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 3 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 5 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


