Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 30,081 lightning strikes (3,796 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Expect a cooling trend with an increase in showers and thunderstorms today and Sunday. Monsoonal moisture will remain over the region through middle of the week.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 12 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 5 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 2 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


