## Current Fire Activity



August 8, 2016 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received 3,227 lightning strikes (123 positive strikes) in the past 24 hours. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will continue today for Northern and Southeastern Arizona. Otherwise, expect temperatures to be near to above normal.

**Arizona State Forestry Activity:** Arizona State Forestry received 9 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 4 wildfires in the past 24 hours. 3 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 24 hours.


