Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 5,499 lightning strikes (359 positive strikes) in the past 48 hours. Expect very warm conditions to gradually trend cooler through the end of the week. Modest monsoon moisture levels look to persist through the weekend with good chances of daily high terrain storms and slight chance of showers across the deserts.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 7 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 1 wildfire in the past 48 hours. 6 resources were dispatched to fires outside of the state in the past 48 hours.


