Statewide Weather Brief: Arizona received 1,522 lightning strikes (143 positive strikes) in the past 4 days. Expect cooler and dryer conditions for most of the area as a cold front continues to move through the state today. Dry and warmer conditions can be expected through the weekend.

Arizona State Forestry Activity: Arizona State Forestry received 8 wildfire reports and dispatched resources to 6 wildfires in the past 4 days. 1 resource was dispatched to a fire outside of the state in the past 4 days.


