

Weeping Bottlebrush

Melaleuca viminalis

At 27 inches in diameter, this tree...

- Provides overall benefits of **\$97** every year!
- Reduces atmospheric carbon by **307** pounds per year.
- Intercepts **1,853** gallons of stormwater runoff per year.



Origin: Native to the states of New South Wales and Queensland in Australia.

Growth Habit: Evergreen, reaching 40 feet in height. Produces beautiful red flowers in Spring.

Temperature: Tolerant to 20 degrees F.

Watering: Deep and infrequent. Dependent on tree aspect, supplemental watering may be needed in addition to regular irrigation.

Weeping Bottlebrush performs well in the hot Phoenix, Arizona environment. It is better suited to this environment than other species in the same genus.
